Neighbourhood Development Plan

NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Middleton Parish Council agreed at the last Parish Council Meeting to approve the preparation of a Neighbourhood Development Plan, now currently in early development under the direction of Councillor Dr. Colin Hayes.

WHY DO WE NEED A DEVELOPMENT PLAN?

Neighbourhood planning is a way for communities to have a say in the future of the places where they live and work. It gives communities the power to produce a plan with real legal weight that directs development in your local area. It helps you:

- choose where you want new homes, shops and offices to be built
- have your say on what those new buildings should look like
- ensure local infrastructure elements can support future development
- protect our environment

WHAT HAPPENS IF WE DO NOT HAVE A NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN?

As residents we would have no say or recourse to District or County Councils on

issues such as new housing developments, environmental protections and a whole host of future initiatives which will impact our Parish.

CAN I HAVE A SAY ABOUT THIS PLAN?

Short answer – *Yes you can.* The Neighbourhood Plan team have a number of Task Groups assigned to investigate policies and produce meaningful reports to ultimately be included in the Plan. These are:

Task Group I - Community Engagement

This group will be raising and maintaining awareness and appointing local ‘champions.’ Organising public meetings, participating in items for the NDP website and preparation for the referendum.

Establishing current state of Parish, identifying needs and opportunities, landscape and natural environment, renewable energy, employment and economy, tourism and environmental impact assessment.

We need volunteers to join these Task Groups and welcome all opinions. If you have expertise in any of the areas or want to be part of decisions relating to the future of the Parish then please, come forward.

relevant Task Group chair who will contact you independently. In terms of commitment you will be required to attend a monthly or bi-monthly task group meeting and help research information required and perhaps help organise community engagement events.

Coronation of His Majesty the King



Coronation of **HIS MAJESTY THE KING** 6th May 2023



*The King's coronation will take place on the **6th May 2023** and **Queen Consort** will be crowned alongside **Charles III**. The service will be held in Westminster Abbey where coronations have taken place for 900 years. King Charles will be the oldest person to be crowned in British History.*

It is thought the coronation will be more modest and shorter than previous ceremonies. The ceremony will reflect the monarch's role today and looks towards the future while staying 'rooted' in long-standing traditions and pageantry.

It has still not been confirmed whether there will be a bank holiday to mark the day, although the fact it falls on a weekend might suggest this is unlikely.

The Queen's coronation on 2nd June 1953 took three hours with a congregation of 8,000 dignitaries. The event was broadcast live on television, attracting record breaking audiences around the world. Thousands lined the streets for a glimpse of the Queen in the gold state coach which has been used for coronations since George IV

The date of the coronation is also the birthday of the Duke and Duchess of Sussex's son Archie – the King's grandson who will be four on the day.

The Parish Council would very much like to hold an event possibly on **Sunday 7th May 2023** to mark the occasion and this will be discussed at the next Parish Council meeting on the 19th October 2022 so please make a note of the date and get it in the diary.

WARM ROOM & COMMUNITY CAFÉ FACILITY

The Parish Council are looking to provide a Warm Room and Community Café facility. It will be based in the Sports Pavilion on Shrubbs Field.



The Sports pavilion will offer a place to keep warm and will be open from 10.00am – 3.00pm and will be open from Monday to Friday offering hot drinks and a place to rest and keep warm. It will enable you to turn off your electricity and heating save you some money and come to the café to meet the volunteers that will be running it and other people wishing to use the facility.

The facility is planned to be opened on Monday 5th December 2022 and will run until the end of February 2023 and will then be reviewed as to whether there is a need for it to continue.

DON'S DIARIES

FRIENDS OF MIDDLETON-ON-SEA POND AND GREEN (CHARITY NO: 1170594)

So, that hot Summer we enjoyed now seems just a distant memory. The first week of November gave us nearly a month's rainfall so the Pond is now filling back up again, creeping towards the edge planting as the water table rises.

The temperatures in early November were way above usual levels, sometimes by 5 or 6 degrees, so leaf drop was slower with some tree varieties, meaning a number of leaf clearances by our volunteers.

We again observed Remembrance Day and the two weeks leading up to the 11th Day of the 11th Month by putting our large poppies on trees around the Pond and Green to show our respect.



Thanks to your generosity in supporting our fund raising event at the Pond we have purchased more Christmas Lights to brighten up the Pond and Green area during December and early January between 4 and 10pm.

Also with your help we have again planted some 2500 Spring bulbs - crocus, daffodil, snowdrop, fritillaria and bluebell as well as more primroses, and expect a colourful Spring!!

Tree pruning has been carried out by professional tree surgeons, and following a specific survey of our much loved horse chestnut on the Middleton Road/Sea Lane corner, we have had to reduce its canopy to assist its natural life span, following a number of areas of decay, found in major limbs. (This tree alone has cost us in the region of £1000!).

We hope to be able to hold a Saturday morning get together for volunteers and supporters in early December to complete our leaf clearance and celebrate the year with mulled wine and mince pies. Christmas carols too!

Work Parties will continue during the Winter period so if you see us there please say hello, as what we are doing is for you the residents of Middleton-on- Sea and the wider community.



Supporting people through the cost-of-living crisis

Is the cost-of-living crisis driving people to loan sharks?



Loan sharks are criminals who target vulnerable people, charging them extortionate interest rates and threatening them or their families with violence if they do not pay back their loan. This crime causes severe financial, social and psychological harm to individuals and families.

Sadly, we are now in a cost-of-living crisis and finances are being continually squeezed; this means people are more likely to go looking for loans and fall prey to a loan shark.

Citizens Advice is running a campaign to promote awareness of loan shark schemes, help victims report them and reach support.

We would like you to join us!

Recent statistics show 1 in 5 victims met a loan shark on social media. Loan sharks are using platforms like Facebook, Instagram and Snapchat to advertise illegal loans and target potential victims. They advertise in online community groups and on local selling pages.

They may seem friendly and accommodating at first, but their behaviour can quickly change.

Please join this campaign and put posters up wherever you can and hand out leaflets on how to report loan sharks.
